

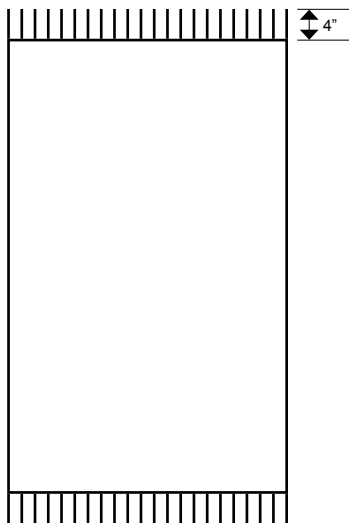

How To Make A Fleece (No-Sew) Blanket

1. If the fabric is still on a bolt, or wrapped up then keep it folded.
2. Measure out 1 1/2 (one and one half) yards of material, and cut at 1 1/2 yards.
3. Cut the salvage (or rough edges) of the fabric off. Save to make Dog toys.
4. Cut 1" strips down the length of the salvage edge of the fabric. Cut into the fabric no more than 4".
5. We do not cut all four sides. The fabric stretches on these salvages edges while it does not stretch on the other sides making them much harder to tie.

Should look like this...



To tie:

- Tie each 1" wide strip on itself.

- The knot should be about 1/2 inch from the body of the fabric to prevent the blanket from bunching up.

- **Note:** Do not tie 1" wide strips together.

If you start with 50 1" strips, you should finish with 50 knots (*not 25 knots*).
